Physicals:

-Please make sure your son's physical is up to date. This needs to be turned into Coach Biglin in order to participate in spring athletics.

Team Camp:

-Team Camp will be from June 20th-23rd. Cost will be \$300. We will attend one day at Eastern Washington University Team Camp. This \$300 will pay for spring football, team camp, and Summer Athletic Conditioning. This is mandatory for all football players. Please include a front and back copy of your child's insurance card. This is important and required. All fees and paperwork must be turned in in order to pick up your gear. You can turn the forms into Kamiakin (attn.: Coach Biglin).

Spring Practices:

-Spring practice for football will begin May 30th. I am finalizing our calendar. I will post to our website and twitter page as soon as I have it finalized. We only get 13 spring practices including team camp. It is important that you attend every session. If you have another sporting event, please talk with your coach and try to make some of the practice. We will do everything we can to accommodate all athletes.

-You can print of a copy of the clearance packet at the following address:


